THE PEOPLE of the State of NEW-YORK, By the Grace of GOD, Free and Independent, To our Sheriff of our County of Ulster, GREETING: We command You, That you take Henry Parselour if he shall be found within your Bailiwic, and him safely keep, so that You may have his Body before our Judges and Justices at our Inferior Court of Common Pleas, which is to be held at Kingston, in and for our said County of Ulster, on the third Tuesday in September next, to answer unto John Delametter the younger of a plea of Trespass on the Case to his damage Thirty Five pounds as is said and have you then there this Writ.
